- **By-law Amendments:**
 - The Office of ESA Home Board Representative shall automatically be filled by the Sr. Past President and her predecessor, serving for two-year terms; and a Juniorette Coordinator to be appointed. Term extended to May 31 to complete report to International Council.
 - All contests to be pre-judged before Convention, with the exception of Scrapbook.
- A new project was selected for a five-year period, beginning in 1968-69 and was the Oklahoma School for the Blind at Muskogee and Jane Brooks School for the Deaf in Chickasha.
- **State Project:** Purchased 4 television sets and 2 air-conditioners in the amount of \$953.88 for Clinton and 3 air-conditioners for Talihina in the amount of \$1,000.00, for a total of \$1,953.88, with a monetary value of kits provided patients of \$1,302.82. This was the final year on this project and over the 16-year period, a total of purchases and monetary gifts to the two sanitoriums was \$49,696.95.
- **Philanthropic:** 13,458 1/2 hours of Service, \$13,806.91 contributed by chapters.
- **Disaster Fund:** 68 Chapters contributed \$619.23.
